Francis Megerlin is Full Professor, health laws and systemics, at the University of Strasbourg / EUCOR since 2016, and Senior Fellow, Berkeley Center for Health Technology (BCHT) at the university of California since 2009. He also lectures in several european and non-european universities and at the Université Internationale Abulcasis des Sciences de la Santé (UIASS) in Rabat, Morocco, whose he is member of the scientific council since 2018. He is a full member, Académie Nationale de Pharmacie, France.

Francis holds a PhD in International & Comparative Law (settlement of complex disputes & ADR laws), and a HDR in Pharmaceutical Sciences (information systems). His teaching covers transversal topics, including health laws and economics, governance of systems and international trade.
